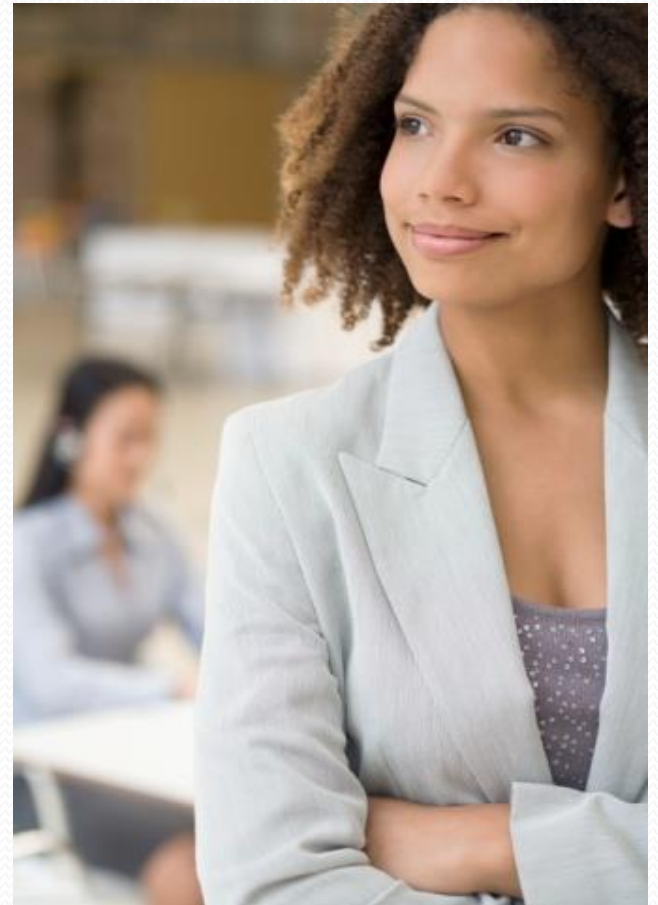


Jesus Saves!

Luke 19: A Tax Collector in a tree

Luke 19:1-3 (NKJV)


